ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR 2017-2018

The year 2017 started with lots of hopes, aspirations, goals & challenges for the foundation.

1. The General meeting of vwf & appointment of the official members

The initial task of the Foundation was to give it a formal structure and appoint the respective Office bearers, Executives, Working committee Members and Advisory Board Members.

The general meeting of VWF was conducted on 29th October 2017, where different posts were assigned to respective office bearers. There is a team of 8 office bearers from the beginning of the foundation holding different posts which includes the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, Finance Secretary, Women coordinator & Youth coordinator. On the very day, a group of 8 (Eight) Executives was selected which keeps on altering every three years. A working committee was also formed & the Members were selected simultaneously for the smooth running of the foundation for undertaking different projects. The Members of the Advisory Board & Patrons were also nominated on the same day. The Foundation spent an amount of Rs. 11,000/- from its annual budget for conducting the above-mentioned meeting.





2. First Educational Assistance provided to the meritorious & needy students

Vivekananda Welfare Foundation adopted 20 students at the beginning of the Academic Session 2017-18 as its first step towards making education accessible to the underprivileged & meritorious students. VWF sponsored the entire educational expenditure to the students for the year 2017 which amounted to a sum of Rs.1,80,000/- which further continued in the following years provided the students kept up their performance.



3. Medical Assistance to the needy patients

The Foundation contributed an amount of Rs.1,20,000/- from the annual budget of the financial year 2017-18 as medical assistance to various patients who were unable to afford medical treatment due to their poor financial condition. The Foundation also accepted the appeal of some extremely critical cases & granted some handsome amount for the medical expenses of the patients suffering from diseases and health issues like brain Tumor, kidney failure, eye operation, etc.

The Foundation also organizes various blood donation camps on regular basis and encourages the people to donate blood and save lives. The Foundation also makes the people aware of the need of blood donation & facilitate to break the stigma of blood donation among the masses through social media platforms and awareness programs.



VWF sponsored the medical expenditure towards the eye operation of the needy patients, Mrs. Swati Chakraborty resident of Lomithi Colony, Dimapur.



VWF stood by a poor and helpless student, Master Biraj Dey, student of Pranab Vidyapith Higher Sec. School, shukanjan, karbi Anglong and the resident of Bokajan, now at Lahorijan (Assam) during his ill health. He was severely suffering from Kidney issues and as per the advice of Doctor, he had to undergo for kidney operation at Chennai Hospital. But the family was unable to manage the expenditure for the treatment of the patient and looking no other alternatives, the helpless family approached to VWF seeking financial assistance. VWF, without a second thought, provided the medical expenditure for his treatment.



A poor and helpless patient, Mr. Basu Gupta of 49 years, resident of B.L.K. Colony, Dimapur had been suffering from Brain Tumor and could not continue the treatment due to the financial crisis going on in the family. The family approached to VWF seeking medical aid for the operation of Brain Tumor of the said patient. The VWF supported the family with financial assistance with a suggestion to let the patient get admitted at NEIGRIHMS, Shillong where operation would be taken place with proper care and with less expenditure. As per our suggestion, the operation was successfully done at Shillong and the team VWF also physically attended the hospital and did all the needful.

4. National Youth Day Programme 2018

Vivekananda Welfare Foundation observed National Youth Day on January 12, 2018 to mark the 155th Birth Anniversary of Swami Vivekananda at Dillai village, 12th mile (Karbianglong District), Assam, 20 km from Dimapur.

The Foundation is based on the ideals & principles of Swami Vivekananda and to pay tribute to the great Icon of our country. What could be a better way than serving the needy people! So, the Foundation keeping in mind the love of Swamiji towards the needy distributed blankets to the poor & old aged. The total expenditure for the Noble cause was around Rs. 50,000/- .

Swamiji had a firm faith in the power & capability of the youth. So, keeping in mind the belief of Swamiji, VWF encouraged many youth volunteers to come forward and actively participate in the Youth Day Programme & in the Blanket distribution process.

Such a gesture of kindness and generosity was initiated by the Foundation to teach & motivate the young members of the society to develop the feeling of love empathy, kindness and respect towards the poor & the senior citizens and dedicatedly work for the upliftment of the society.

The NGO also celebrated its 3rd Foundation day on 12th January 2018 along with the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda which is also the National Youth Day. The entire celebration was dedicated & focused towards the need of the poor and the less privileged.

Vivekananda Welfare Foundation, Dimapur came forward on 28th March, 2018 in providing assistance and relieving some anxiety of 18 plot holders of Y.Zhimo Colony, Signal Basti, Dimapur by distributing CGI Sheet to each of the families for making their house afresh as the house with all household goods were charred to ashes by devastating fire that broke out in the area on March 24 last.
